



Notice 09 - FeNCAA Election Results 2025 - (Term: 2025–2027)

The Election Commission is pleased to announce the results of the election to constitute the FeNCAA Executive Committee for the 2025–2027 term. The names of the elected members, their positions, and the states or territories they represent are listed in **Table 1**.

In accordance with the FeNCAA Constitution, the tenure of the Executive Committee is two years. Except for the **Queensland (QLD)** and **Northern Territory (NT)** State Coordinator positions, which remain vacant, all Executive Committee and State Coordinator positions were elected unopposed.

As stipulated in the FeNCAA Constitution, the newly formed Executive Committee will appoint members to fill the vacant QLD and NT State Coordinator positions.
